

BRICK AND ALLIED CRAFT UNION OF CANADA 2024/2025 SCHOLARSHIP AWARDS

OBJECTIVE

The purpose of these awards is to encourage academic excellence and the pursuit of higher education for the children of BACU members.

These Academic Awards are given for academic achievement and future potential not financial need and are applicable for all Canadian Educational Institutions which have Provincial Degree-Granting powers, and at Canadian Community Colleges.

There are no restrictions on the program of study or discipline selected by the applicant, providing that courses taken satisfy degree/diploma requirements.

The selection of recipients' is determined by a committee of the Executive Board or a committee as selected by the Executive Board of the Brick and Allied Craft Union of Canada.

CRITERIA TO QUALIFY

- 1. Applicants must be dependents, (natural or adopted), of members of the BACU and a Canadian Citizen.
- 2. Applicants must be entering a full-time undergraduate degree program or college program, at a qualifying institution in the year of application. The college/certificate must be a minimum of two-years in duration.
- 3. Applicants must submit all official transcripts from their university/college or last year of secondary school showing the required completed coursework.
- 4. Must complete the scholarship application form (enclosed).
- 5. Applicants must submit a short essay no more than 500 words on "Being a Canadian comes with responsibilities. What do you think makes a great Canadian?" (attach essay to application)
- 6. Proof of admission or conditional admission. (letter of acceptance)
- 7. No late applications will be accepted.



VALUE AND DURATION

One-Thousand five hundred (\$1500.00) dollars will be awarded in the year of attendance of post secondary education.

Recipients will receive a bursary until the completion of their undergraduate studies (maximum of four (4) years) or completion of college certificate or other qualifying institution.

OBLIGATIONS OF RECIPIENTS

To submit all completed forms of the application fulfilling all the requirements as outlined on the application.

The candidate is responsible for making arrangements for meeting the requirements of admission to the post secondary institution and the eligibility criteria of that institution is met as outlined in the scholarship procedure.

They must remain in good academic and disciplinary standing for each year of attendance.

EACH YEAR, the recipient must submit to the BACU proof of admission to the institution to receive payment and remain in good academic and disciplinary standing for each year. As the awards are considered income the BACU will issue the relevant T4A slip for income tax purposes.

Recipient must provide proof of continuation of studies each year prior to the academic year starting in the courses in which the scholarship was originally awarded for.

Submissions must be received NO LATER THAN Dec 1, 2024.
